### Narrative

Incident: Information

On December 8, 2015, During the town of Bluffton Council meeting, Skip Hoagland was removed at the request of Mayor Lisa Sulka during public comment.

Prior to the public comment portion of the meeting, Mayor Sulka read the rule pertaining to any citizen wishing to make a public comment. Mr. Hoagland began his comment and was told by Mayor Sulka he was being disrespectful. Mr. Hoagland continued his comments and again was told by Mayor Sulka that he was being disrespectful. When Mr. Hoagland continued, Mayor Sulka advised he was done and asked for him to leave.

At this point I had Sergeant Carmany come to the front of the council chamber and we asked Mr. Hoagland to leave. Mr. Hoagland complied and left without further incident.

After the council meeting ended I was informed by Sergeant M. Ferrelli that Mr. Hoagland wished to speak with someone regarding his removal from the council meeting. I spoke with Mr. Hoagland by phone and he advised he felt his removal was unwarranted. I explained to Mr. Hoagland that the mayor cited rules for public comment and it was her decision to have him removed was based on him not following those rules.

Mr. Hoagland sounded very irate on the phone and told me that "This is a major deal and that he has gotten the FBI, the Island Packet and Bluffton Today involved." Mr. Hoagland went on to say everytime he attends the council meetings he feels as if "The mayor runs her meeting like a college pep rally." Mr. Hoagland continued to tell me that I work for him and that he does not work for me. I advised Mr. Hoagland I would document the incident for him.
